Orientation is mandatory for all summer program members to attend with their parent/guardian(s) and will be held on the following dates:

June 15th, 16th, 17th from 5:30-6:30p.m.
June 21st, 22nd, 23rd from 5:30-6:30p.m.
July 28th and August 4th from 5:30-6:30p.m.

Club Card Policy is enforced every day, club members must bring their club card with them. A free card is provided with membership. Replacement cards cost \$5.00 each.

Cost per week is \$10.00 per member. This fee includes breakfast and lunch and access to all programs. The summer program runs for 7 weeks. The weekly program starts July 5th and ends the week of August 15th. Each week runs from Monday through Friday from 9:00 - 5:00p.m.

Early Drop Off and Late Pick up options are available. The cost of this program is \$25.00 per week per member for each program. You must pre register for this program no later than the Thursday prior by 5:00p.m. **The Early Drop off program** enables you to drop off your child as early as 8:00a.m. and the **Late Pick up program** enables you to pick up your child as late as 6:00p.m.

Late Fees if you are unable to pick up your child by 5:00p.m. please call the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Lowell to let us know you will be late. After a 5 minute grace period a charge of \$5.00 will be assessed for every 15 minutes thereafter. Please note parents are still expected to pay their fees even if they call.

Age Appropriate Programming is an important element of the summer program. Club members will be separated into age groups throughout the summer to ensure their experience is a positive one! All ages groups will have access to all summer programs at different times throughout the day. *(The only program space reserved for teens only is our fitness center. The equipment is not suitable for our younger members)*

Teen Nights are held every week on Monday and Wednesday nights for ages 13-18. You do not need to pay the weekly fee for this program, however, you must have a membership application filled out and signed by a parent/guardian to attend. The program begins at 6:00pm and ends at 8:00p.m.
